## Representation

Weingarten rights guarantee an employee the right to Union representation during an investigatory interview. These rights were established by the Supreme Court in 1975 in the case of J. Weingarten, must be claimed by the employee. The supervisor has no obligation to inform an employee of his/her right to Union representation. If you feel that your supervisor is questioning you to obtain information which could be used as a basis for discipline or if you are asked to defend your conduct, especially if you have a reasonable belief that your answer may result in discipline or discharge, you have a right to ask for Union representation.
